SAMPLE INTRODUCTION:

"I would like to introduce today's performance which is presented by the Music Center of Los Angeles County. This performance features the **KHAC CHI ENSEMBLE** (pronounced *kack chee*), two renowned musicians who are natives of Vietnam. They will perform music and songs of the mountain people of that country, as well as Vietnamese classical and folk music. Their presentation features rare traditional instruments including a long flute played by two people at the same time! Please welcome the **KHAC CHI ENSEMBLE!**"



PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE DAY:

Space:

- 15' x 12' minimum.
- Portable stages must be sturdy, securely lashed, level and smooth.

Dressing Area:

- One private dressing area will be needed near the stage.

Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Equipment:

- Two armless chairs
- Electrical outlet(s)
- Heavy extension cord
- Two small, high tables (or stands) for speakers
- One dolly or cart (for moving equipment)
- Water and cups

ON PERFORMANCE DAY:

Arrival:

- 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.

Parking:

- One space close to the venue for loading and unloading.

Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the performers and to stay and help as needed.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the venue, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
