MUSIC·CENTER

PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE DAY:

Space:

- 30'w x 30'd minimum.
- No portable stages.
- Elevated stage is preferred.

Surface:

- Wooden surface preferred
- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Dressing Area:

- Two dressing areas are needed, preferably near the stage.

Equipment:

- Audio system with CD player
- Two microphones

ON PERFORMANCE DAY:

Arrival:

- 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.

Parking:

- Four spaces. One should be as close to the venue as possible for loading and unloading of equipment.

Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the performers and to stay and help as needed.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the venue, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
