A convenient parking option is to park at the Music Center parking garage on Grand Avenue between Temple and 1st Street. If you are using a GPS device to find the parking structure, use 135 N. Grand Avenue, Los

Angeles, CA 90012. You'll need to arrive after 4:30pm to get the \$9 parking rate (earlier arrivals are at a significantly higher rate). Upon exiting the parking structure, walk north on Grand Avenue for one block and enter the Center Theatre Group Annex building on the northwest corner of Temple and Grand. You can also access the Seminar by taking the Metro Red Line and taking the Civic Center stop.
